Swansea's Liberty Stadium improves Premium Club Member security with Intelligent Time Systems

Liberty Stadium, Swansea's world-class multi-use sporting venue and home to Swansea FC has installed an access control system from Intelligent Time Systems. The new security system is installed on the second and third floors of the stadium covering the venue's management suites and hospitality areas. Premium Club Members and staff have been issued with swipe cards to access the controlled areas.

The new system, which covers 1200 members at the 60+ match days per year and other hospitality and corporate events, means that the validity of membership cards is checked every time they are used. Previously cards were issued with seats, but could not be checked electronically and therefore duplicate cards were difficult to identify.

Additionally, the system is used to collect time and attendance data for the 400 to 500 staff working on match days. Next season, it is planned to include stewards on the system.
